Enjoy it all on the patio decked out in nautical décor while digging into the **Ahi Poke**, fresh raw ahi marinated in soy sauce, ginger, crushed red pepper and sesame oil and served with crispy wonton chips.

Skip the picnic and dine instead in the lively Gaslamp Quarter at [Lazy Hippo](#), downtown's most adorable eatery for all of your breakfast and lunch needs. This one-stop brunch spot brings a cute and quirky atmosphere to the plate matched with creative takes on both modern and traditional dishes, healthy breakfast alternatives, and savory favorites. Take your seat on the charmingly whimsical patio for a quaint breakfast experience complete with the unforgettable **Fried Chicken Waffle**, Belgian style waffles alternating with three pieces of crispy fried chicken breast and topped with hot cinnamon apple sauce and warm syrup.

If you can't get enough of the great outdoors, then [The Village at Pacific Highlands Ranch](#) is the ideal place to dine!
